Memory Cafés are for people with mild to moderate cognitive impairment AND their care partners who want to remain socially engaged with others traveling the same dementia journey.



A Memory Café is a place where people with cognitive loss/dementia symptoms and their care partners can get together in a safe, supportive environment to interact, play reminiscing games, find support, share concerns and information, and celebrate life without feeling embarrassed or misunderstood. Memory Cafés encourage a sense of “normalcy” for the people with dementia-related diagnoses and those who love them. It’s a place where friendship and acceptance allow participants to laugh and have fun once again.
